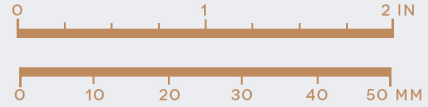




HOW TO USE THIS RING SIZER

- Use a ruler to confirm the printed paper size in the box to the right.
- Measure your finger at the end of the day when it will be at its largest.
- Do not measure fingers when they are cold or damp, this is when they will be at their smallest.
- Pull the sizer snug to produce an accurate size.
- Ring bands over 5mm in width may fit your finger tighter than rings of the same size in narrower widths.

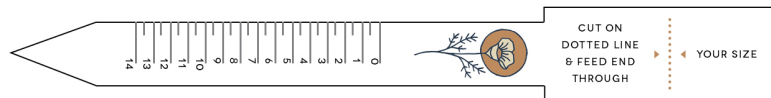
CONFIRM PRINT OUT SIZE



Measure the above bar to ensure it has printed exactly 2 inches, or 50mm, long. If this measurement is not accurate, this size guide can not provide desired results.

TIPS FOR PRINTING OUT RING SIZER

1. Cut along the solid black line below and make a slit along the dotted line.
2. Wrap the sizer around your finger, numbers are facing out. Insert the pointed end through the slit in the opposite end. Adjust the ring sizer around the widest part of the intended finger. It should fit snug but should still be able to be slipped off the finger.
3. The number that lines up with the slit is your ring size! Quarter sizes are also available if your sizer indicates that you are between whole and half sizes.



MEASURE A RING

1. Choose a ring that fits well on the finger you are purchasing the ring for.
2. Lay the ring over the circles below to find the one that matches closest to the inside edge of your ring.
3. The one that matches is your ring size! If the ring falls between two of the sizes, order the quarter size in the middle.

TIPS FOR MEASURING RING SIZE

MEASURING BASICS

Your ring should have a comfortable fit, snug enough that it will not fall off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle with some resistance. For best results measure your finger later in the day. It is recommended to measure finger size 3 to 4 times for an accurate reading.

TEMPERATURE

Do not measure fingers in extremely hot or cold temperatures. Fingers are at their smallest when cold. In the heat they expand. Measure your ring size at a comfortable, room temperature.

WHEN TWO SIZES SEEM TO FIT

If you are hesitating between two ring sizes, always go with the larger one.

DON'T USE STRINGS

Strings can slip or stretch. It's best to use a proper ring sizing tool for the most accurate measurement. When in doubt visit a local jewelry shop to be sized.

LARGE KNUCKLES

If your knuckle is a lot larger than the base of your finger, measure both the base of your finger and your knuckle. Select a size in between the two.

WIDE BANDS

When purchasing a ring with a wide band, you will need to order one half to one full size up. This is dependant on the width of the band. If you need advice on determining your size for a wide band, please contact us.

BUYING A RING AS A GIFT

Borrow a ring for the correct finger and use the ring measurements on the bottom of the first page to determine its size. We recommend measuring with a plain band. Please make sure beforehand that the ring you are purchasing can be resized. Rings with inlaid stones or patterns all the way around usually cannot be resized. Most other rings can be resized for a nominal fee.

MOST COMMON US SIZES

The most commonly purchased women's ring sizes range from size 5 to 7. Size 6.5 is the most common ring size. Men's rings typically range from size 8 to 14. The most commonly purchased men's ring sizes range from size 9 to 10-1/2. Size 10 is the most common ring size.

INTERNATIONAL SIZE CONVERSION

Determine your ring size according to your country's standard. The international ring size chart on page 2 will help you convert your size to the corresponding US ring size for your order. We guarantee to provide the size that is ordered, but we cannot be responsible for conversions or fitting.

BRACELET SIZING GUIDE

SIZE CHART

Below is a basic guideline to bracelet sizes. Please note that this is an approximate measurement. Follow the steps to the right for a more accurate measurement.

New born-6 mo.	3"
6-12 months	3.5"
12-14 months	4"
2-5 years	4.5"
6-8 years	5"
9-13 years	5.5"
WOMEN'S	LENGTH
Petite	5.75"

MEN'S	LENGTH
Small	6.75"-7"

HOW TO FIND AN ACCURATE SIZE

Measure your wrist below the wrist bone (where you would normally wear your bracelet) using a flexible measuring tape. This is your wrist size.

To find your bracelet size, increase your wrist measurement by the increment below, based on how you want the bracelet to fit.

- Add .25" to .5" for a snug fit
- Add .75" to 1" for a comfort fit
- Add 1-1.25" for a loose fit

OUR MEASUREMENTS

Many of our pieces are handcrafted and one of a kind. We measure each as accurately as possible.

Inside Measurement

This is the part that touches your skin. This number is the entire inside length, end to end, of the cuff or bracelet. This measurement does not include the opening. We do not measure the length of the top of the bracelet.

Opening Size

This is the measurement of the distance in a straight line between the two ends of the bracelet. This opening is commonly 1"-1.25"

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
